Debra Ary, P.E., Superintendent
Production and Pumping for Wichita Water Utilities

Deb manages the operations of the Water Treatment Plant, Cheney Reservoir and the Equus Beds Well Field and is in charge of the City's Equus Beds Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) project. She has been with the City since 1999 and has worked for both Public Works and Water Utilities. During this time she has designed several small paving, water and sewer line projects, drainage improvements including rehabilitation of portions of the concrete lined drainage canal along I-35, and has overseen the design and construction of the residuals handling facility for the Treatment Plant, new generator facility and improvements to Hess Pump Station.

While a licensed as a Civil Engineer (P.E.), she has a bachelor's degree in music education, minor in mathematics and bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering, all from Wichita State University.
